

CITY OF MONTGOMERY/THE M TRANSIT PUBLIC NON-DISCRIMINATION NOTICE

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color or national origin in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance. Specifically, Title VI provides that “no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subject to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.”

(42 USC Section 2000d-1)

Individuals or organizations who believe they have been denied the benefit of, excluded from participation in, or subject to discrimination on the grounds of race, color, or national origin by the M Transit can file a signed, written complaint by:

- 1) Submitting a signed, written complaint with contact information

- 5) A complainant may file a complaint directly with the Federal Transit Administration by filing a complaint with the Office of Civil Rights, Attention: Title VI Program Coordinator, East Building, 5th Floor-TCR, 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE, Washington, DC 20590
